We supply physical, occupational and speech therapy services to all ages, from 5 to 95 years old.

We serve clients who have arthritic conditions, balance and gait issues, and debility (weakness) issues.

We also do a lot of rehabilitation for replacement surgeries, such as hip, knee and even total shoulder replacements.

We are very big on client education from a wellness perspective. We're also big on support groups such as for nutrition, arthritic conditions and amputees. We offer our site for use by a lot of support groups, and we facilitate them.

Many conditions we work with include pain and walking issues, and we take a proactive approach in identifying current

and potential future problems. In response, we put strong, individualized evidence-based programs together to deal with the pain, weakness, balance and gait issues we identify.

We have a program now geared toward oncological patients, either ongoing or finishing up their cancer treatments.

We also get into some sports rehab as well, in terms of young athletes who have had injuries or surgeries. We have specific therapies for rehabilitation, and follow through with sport-specific training.

We have a physical therapist, two physical therapy assistants, an occupational therapist, and two client-services specialists.

Entry: Fox started out as a Medicare Part B house-call practice in 1998 with Dr. Tim Fox. Some 13 years, 550 therapists and seven states later, we're taking that same philosophy and culture into the outpatient segment. This outpatient clinic is the second within Fox. The first one is in Cape May Court House off Route 9.

The future: We see the need for outpatient clinics and want to make sure we do it smartly. We are looking to grow, but want to make sure we do it right. We understand people are shopping their services more, and we are preparing ourselves for that, making sure people are treated with the highest level of care when they visit us.
