Tim Fox Named *Therapy Times*' Most Influential

[Therapy Times](#) recently named Tim Fox, PT, DPT, GCS, founder and CEO of Fox Rehabilitation™, Cherry Hill, NJ, “Most Influential Physical Therapist.”

Fox Rehabilitation is a private practice of full-time physical, occupational, and speech therapists who provide Geriatric House Calls.™ Fox's interest in the unique needs of the elderly allowed him to identify a significant limitation in how the elderly access and receive necessary physical therapy. While modern medicinal advances have fortunately prolonged lives and while elderly patients are increasingly living out their lives at home, home needs must be addressed proportionally.

Fox started his practice in 1998 after recognizing that he could do house calls to the elderly population under Medicare Part B. Today, Fox Rehabilitation employs more than 400 clinicians who make more than 9,000 house calls per week to elderly patients throughout seven states. Its mission includes developing a line of access to community-dwelling older adults to high-quality, evidence-based physical therapy.

The American Physical Therapy Association (APTA) named [Fox Rehabilitation the first private practice to offer APTA-accredited, postgraduate training program in geriatrics.](#)

Fox graduated in 1995 from Thomas Jefferson University (TJU) in Philadelphia with a Master of Science in Physical Therapy. He received his board certification as a Geriatric Clinical Specialist (GCS) in 2008 from the American Board of Physical Therapy Specialties and went on to complete his Doctor of Physical Therapy (DPT) in 2009 from TJU. He is also an APTA Credentialed Clinical Instructor (CCI). He holds a seat on TJU's Board of Trustees and on the Scientific and Academic Affairs Committee. Fox has also established two endowed scholarships with TJU: The Fox Rehabilitation Scholarship for the Advancement of Occupational Therapy, in memory of Margaret Sood; and The Fox Rehabilitation Scholarship for the Advancement of Physical Therapy.
