Dr. Tim Fox Named “Most Influential Physical Therapist in the Nation” by *Therapy Times*

Cherry Hill, NJ – September 22, 2010 – Tim Fox, PT, DPT, GCS, founder of Fox Rehabilitation™, has been named the most influential physical therapist in the nation by the editors of *Therapy Times*.

Tim Fox was cited for his leadership in developing a way, under Medicare Part B, to provide therapy for geriatric patients in their homes, assisted living facilities, and adult day care centers. He founded Fox Rehabilitation in 1998. Today, the practice employs 600, including 400 physical, occupational, and speech therapists who make more than 10,000 Geriatric House Calls™ each week. Fox Rehabilitation serves patients in seven states, including New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, Delaware, Virginia, South Carolina, and Florida.

“I am grateful to receive this designation, but it wouldn’t have been possible without the remarkable therapists and staff who make up Fox Rehabilitation,” says Fox. “Every day, I’m thankful for the privilege of leading an organization that’s making a real difference in the lives of thousands of seniors.”

Fox believes that by using best practice guidelines and the latest evidence, and by insisting on high clinical and interpersonal standards from himself and his colleagues, Fox Rehabilitation patients should perform at their most optimal functional level, regardless of past and current medical conditions.

In addition to his dedication to Fox Rehabilitation, Tim Fox is dedicated to the education of the next generation of therapists.
